2015-2016 School Land Trust Funds Goals

Last year our goals were as follows:

- #1: The number of kindergarten through third grade students reading on grade level would increase by at least 1%.
- #2: The number of 4th-6th grade students proficient on the SAGE test would increase by at least 2%.

What we did to work towards that goal:

- *Target Time (targeted instruction for students by grade level and achievement level)
- *Double Dosing (for students that need extra practice)
- *Teachers observed and discussed best teaching practices
- *Hired aides to work with students
- *Purchased books for the library and classrooms
- *Purchased technology (iPads and Chromebooks) for student use to improve literacy
- *Purchased math and science supplies.

We were given \$61,355 from the School Land Trust funds last year. This money was used to fund the items listed above to meet our 2015-2016 goals. These funds helped our students make great progress and we are very grateful for them.

Early-out Mondays

Early-out Mondays are an excellent opportunity for the faculty to focus on students. Teachers and administrators utilize this time to map curriculum according to the Utah core, create common assessments, and discuss best practices in order help students achieve at high levels. Each Monday, teachers focus on the following four critical questions:

1. What do we want students to learn?
2. How will we know what students have learned?
3. How will we respond to students who aren't learning?
4. How will we respond to students who already know the material?

2016-2017 School Land Trust Funds and Goal

Our goals for this year are as follows:

Goal #1: The percentage of K-3rd grade students reaching proficiency on the DIBELS by the end of the year will increase by 2% as compared to the fall 2016 assessment.

Goal #2: The percentage of 4th-6th grade students reaching proficiency will increase by 2% in all SAGE tested subjects at the end of the 2016-2017 school year as compared to the previous year.

Some of the things that we are doing to achieve this goal are:

- *Target Time (targeted instruction for students by grade level and achievement level)
- *Double Dosing (for students that need extra practice)
- *Teachers observing peers and discussing best teaching practices
- *Regular teacher professional development
- *Extra teacher collaboration time for goal progress evaluation
- *Purchasing technology to help teachers track and pinpoint specific student needs and goal progress
- *Hiring aides to work with specific students
- *Purchasing technology (iPads and Chromebooks) for student use
- *Summer collaboration for math, science, and literacy instruction.

We have been given \$73,450 from the School Land Trust funds this year. We will use this money to fund the items listed above. These funds will support our efforts to reach our goals. We appreciate the support of the teachers and parents and are grateful for the funds we have been given to help our students progress and achieve at high levels.
