Totals we are a little past where we should be on the yellow. Most other items were close or right on. Hardware is a little below.

This is the number we thought we had \$77,471.

It turns out we didn't have a carryover. So it will have to come out of the aide money

\$61150.81 has been spent, most of remaining will have to go to aides.

We unanimously agreed we will allow Mindy to send out an email asking if people are willing to change the date for SCC meetings from Wednesday to Tuesdays. Bylaws say that we can appoint someone to fill the vacancy. Julie Thompson was on the ballot at the beginning of the year.
