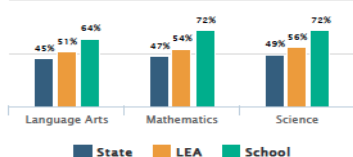

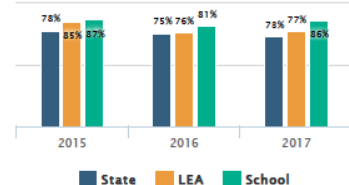
#### DIBELS K – 3<sup>rd</sup>
